Methods of payment

For example, if you are a strict vegetarian, it may be more important to be placed with a family that prepares vegetarian food, rather than with a non-smoking family.

Vegetarian applicants please note: Vegetarianism is relatively unknown in Spain. If you are a vegetarian or a vegan, and we cannot place you with a vegetarian family, you may need to buy some of your own food, or eat the same food / similar meals several times per week.

Religious considerations: Catholicism represents the majority of the Spanish host families and population in Spain on the whole. Special dietary requirements dictated by religion can be difficult to accommodate. Please take this into consideration as you set your expectations for your time in Spain.
